Steve called the meeting to relative order in the AAC Police Station.

Prior Meeting Minutes: The May 9 minutes were posted on the Web site and distributed before the meeting. With no corrections offered, they were approved on a motion by Denis, seconded by Mike.

Treasurer's Report: Terry reported:

Last month report balance: \$668.67 (4/29/17 statement)

Account activity for month: \$668.67 - \$20 M.Cherry MBN - \$5 M&T Bank Fee = \$643.67 (5/26/17 statement).

Current available balance: \$643.67 - \$30 Mike's BASS = \$613.67 + \$30 + \$18 BF cash = \$661.67. No corrections or additions were offered. The report was accepted as stated.

Conservation: Nothing of note offered.

Tournaments: Andy and Steve recapped the Black Hills lunker weigh-in. We agreed it didn't work and stressed the fish and us. We will rely on the length measurement in future. We need a demo of the measurement procedure at the meeting before such a tournament.

Andy reviewed our jobs for the Marshyhope Open August 19th. He has the permit. Jim will chair the captains' meeting and the awards ceremony. Andy clarified that Steve is bringing the tables, tents, chairs and ice chests of water, with Kevin's help. The emailed applications will be put on the sheets and leader board prior to the event. Jim and Alan, and Steve and Kevin plan to fish it and launch last in the order so they can assist with morning duties. They can return with the other competitors. Weigh-in will be in #.## decimal format. Andy was applauded for his work as TD. Yeah! Andy!
